Event date: October 24, 2015 (Saturday)

Objectives:

1. To provide an interactive and informative platform of learning and exposure for students and event participants.
2. To highlight and raise awareness of global issues and trends in an interactive and fun manner.
3. To spur event participants towards taking action to mediate these global issues.
4. To enhance the celebratory mood of the overall event.

Participation criteria:

1. Participants must be enrolled in a programme of study at Taylor's University.
2. Participants will sign up to participate in groups of 4 – 5 members per group.
3. Accepted submissions for participation must achieve the objectives stated above.

General guidelines:

1. Potential participants must submit all submissions online to the Life Skills Development team for review by **September 25, 2015 (Friday)**.

2. Selected applicants will be contacted by **October 2, 2015 (Friday)** with confirmation of the following, *which will depend on the idea for the exhibit as outlined in the initial submission*:
 - **Seed-funding provided**
 - **Size of the booth allocated**
 - **Any other resources allocated, if applicable**
3. Participants will set up the exhibit at 7.30am on October 24, 2015 and keep it running throughout the day (except for the duration of the keynote session and forum).
4. The main judging session will be held on October 24, 2015 between 11.45 am and 1.45pm.
5. The crowd in general and the guests of honour for the event will serve as the judges, with the guests' scoring carrying a heavier weightage.

Judging criteria:

The winning exhibits will effectively fulfill the objectives above by meeting the following criteria:

- i. **Informative:** The exhibit provides sufficient contextual information provided to raise awareness and establish urgency for the cause concerned
- ii. **Creative and interactive:** The exhibit provides an extraordinary way of engaging visitors through various interactive means.
- iii. **Presentation:** The exhibit is built and presented professionally; the presenters stationed at the booth are well-versed and knowledgeable in the subject matter.

The judging will be done on a total score of **30 points**, with **10 points allocated for each criterion**.

There will be 3 prizes given out for:

- i. **Most Informative Booth:** Garners the highest score in criteria i above.
- ii. **Most Creative and Interactive Booth:** Garners the highest score in criteria ii above.
- iii. **Crowd's Favourite Booth:** Voted favourite booth by the crowd.
- iv. **Best Overall Booth:** Garners the highest total score.
